Visa, residence permit

Visa

EU/EEA students can enter Croatia with a valid ID card or passport and do not need an entrance visa/student visa.

Non-EU/EEA students coming from a country that has a visa-regime with the Republic Croatia need to apply for a visa via the Croatian embassy in their home country before departing for Croatia.

Residence permit

All exchange students who intend to stay in Croatia longer than 90 days need to register at the Central police station if staying for more than 3 months to regulate the Residence Permit.

Health insurance

All exchange students must have health insurance during their stay in Croatia.

EU/EAA students may use the health care services upon presentation of the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) that is valid during the entire period spent in Croatia.

Non-EU/EAA students are required possess international travel and health insurance issued by an insurance company in their home country that is valid in Croatia. Such insurance must include repatriation coverage for medical reasons, urgent medical care and/or emergency treatment in a hospital. Student will need to submit a proof of medical insurance upon arrival when applying for the first temporary permit.

Students coming from a country that has an bilateral agreement on health security with Croatia are entitled to use the emergency health care services during their stay in Croatia. Upon arrival to Croatia students will report to the Croatian Health Insurance Fund (Hrvatski zavod za zdravstveno osiguranje – HZZO) and submit the relevant document issued by national insurance provider. The HZZO will issue a document that enables exchange students to use the health services within the Croatian health system. The document is issued without additional charges.
